

Call For Proposals

The Friends of Frontenac Park Research Award

Due Date: November 30, 2017

Opportunity

This annual award provides a full-time post-secondary student with a stipend to conduct research in Frontenac Park. The award is valued at \$2,500.

Eligibility

The student will be selected on the basis of academic excellence, merit, and the quality of the proposal.

A proposal from any discipline will be considered providing that the research will be related to Frontenac Park. This includes, but is not limited to, research on the biology, geology, hydrology, history, sociology or human geography of the Park, or expressions of art related to the Park, such as photography or literature. It is expected that the recipient will use the Park itself as the subject of research, though archival research may also be considered.

Applicants should submit a 500-word letter of application, including project and research details, along with a proposed budget for use of the funds, and copy of transcripts, to the Friends of the Frontenac Park at frontenacpark@frontenacpark.ca. The recipient of the award will be chosen by a committee selected by the Friends of the Frontenac Park, and consisting of a minimum of three members of the Board of Directors and the Superintendent of Frontenac Park or a delegate.

The deadline for submission is November 30, 2017.

The successful applicant will be notified by December 20, and be eligible to submit expenses related to research in Frontenac Park between January 1 and December 31, 2017.
